Provide SESS Ltd throughout all business functions ensures that we adhere to GDPR Regulations 2018.

These principles require that personal information is:

- processed fairly and lawfully
- processed for one or more specified and lawful purposes, and not further processed in any way that is incompatible with the original purpose
- adequate, relevant and not excessive
- accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date
- kept for no longer than is necessary for the purpose for which it is being used
- processed in line with the rights of individuals
- kept secure with appropriate technical and organisational measures taken to protect the information
- not transferred outside the European Economic Area (the European Union member states plus Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein) unless there is adequate protection for the personal information being transferred.

Provide SESS Ltd ensures that all documents and information received is handled correctly and lawfully adhering to the GDPR Regulations 2018 to include staff files, client information and marketing data.

Provide SESS Ltd ('Provide') respects your privacy and your rights to control your personal data. Our principle guidelines are simple: we will be clear about the data we collect and why; your data is protected by us; we do not, and will not, sell your data to third parties.

This Privacy Policy (the 'Policy') explains the personal information we collect from you, either directly or indirectly, and how we will use it. The Policy also covers the choices you can make about the data we collect, and how you can control these decisions. We also give more detail about:

The personal information we collect

All such data processors are subject to a duty of care under Article 28 of the General Data Protection Regulation. We will share information as lawfully required with Government bodies such as HMRC and regulatory bodies such as the SIA.

Our policy towards children

Changes to our Privacy Policy


